Happy New Year! Some good news about our fundraising last term. The Christmas Fair raised £569.49, and the proceeds from the Christmas raffle and ticket sales was £375.20, giving a **grand total of £944.69!** Many thanks to all who helped with the organisation, and supported the events.

There are a lot of events planned for this term, some familiar ones, and others that are new for us.



We will be marking **World Religion Day** on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> January. This is an opportunity for the children to think about what their religion means to them, and to consider the similarities between each of the religions. Children are encouraged to talk to and listen to others about their own religion if they have one, and that of others'. In the world that we live in it is important that the children understand the basic tenets of all religions.

All of the children will be doing a lesson around this on Monday, which will build on the work that they do in RE lessons throughout the year.

We are having a **STEM Week** at the end of January – 22<sup>nd</sup> to 26<sup>th</sup>. This is focused on Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths – a chance to raise the profile of these subjects, and to talk to the children about careers in these areas.



There are more **parent workshops** planned for this term. A Maths one on 24<sup>th</sup> January, and a Science one on 27<sup>th</sup> February. More details will be sent out nearer the time.

The national organisation, **Family First**, have started to produce a magazine written for families. It is full of articles about a very wide range of questions that we as families have, and I am sure that there will be some articles in there that are of interest to you.
