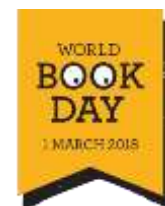


As you will know from the flyer that went home recently, we are holding another **Parents' Information** session next Tuesday 27th March. This one is focusing on **Science**.
