

Safeguarding Children

Keeping the Physical Environment Safe

Security systems in place to monitor visitors to the school – see Visitors Procedures.

Playground areas clearly bounded – boundaries regularly checked.

Members of staff on duty in the playground need to place themselves so as to be able to see the entire space.

Classroom and group room doors all have windows in them which remain uncovered to allow adults to see in.

Children generally work with staff in open communal areas.

Staff working in rooms on their own with a child leave doors open.

Toilet doors in nursery are half doors.

Toilet areas closely monitored by staff on duty at playtime and at lunchtime.
