Dear Parents / Carers

We are quickly coming to the end of the second term of the year, and it has been another packed one. The children have all been working extremely hard, and are making great progress in their learning.

Parents' Evening

Starting the session earlier seemed to work well, and the feedback was that there was enough time to talk about your child, and that their teachers know them very well!

As soon as the survey closes on Thursday we will start to look at your feedback, and any suggestions that you might have made.

KS1 had fun with their event on the Tuesday – Year 5 helped to organise it in the playground, and the children really enjoyed it!

The **Music Concert** on Friday went very well. The children performed brilliantly, and loving having such a large audience – thank you to all who came and supported.



We are taking every opportunity to raise the profile of **cycling** in the school. As you know we are running an **adults' cycling course** after Easter – there was information about it at Parents' Evening last week, and we have 12 parents signed up to it so far. I am sure that they will really enjoy it, and will then be able to have family trips out cycling as a result – the children will love it!

We will also be running a **cycling club for the children** after Easter – there will be more information about this coming out soon.

We will also be having our monthly **Reading Buddies** session on Tuesday afternoon where the children pair up with an older / younger child for a spot of enjoyable reading. I am looking forward to this as it was so lovely to see when we had our first session on World Book Day. Also a reminder about the **Extreme Reading Challenge** that was set – we want photos of children reading in unusual places! Please send in your photos to us so that we can put together an eye-catching display in school.



The **new summer menus** will start immediately after Easter, and the menus will be sent to you after the holiday.
