

Year 6 SATs Results 2014

41 children were assessed at the end of Year 6 in 2014. Nineteen children arrived at Manor during the course of KS2 (46%).

Five children arrived at Manor in either Years 5 or 6 (20%). One of these children arrived at Manor from abroad so their results have been taken out of the final figures.

The Value Added figure for 2013 data (progress made since Year 2 in all subjects combined) is 101.5.

This is, statistically, significantly above the national figure and puts Manor in the <u>top 9% of schools nationally for progress</u> made. (2014 data not available yet)
